Academic Excellence:

UNIFAL-MG, renowned for its commitment to academic excellence, was founded in Alfenas city in 1914. UNIFAL's roots can be traced to its predecessor, the Escola de Farmácia e Odontologia de Alfenas (School of Pharmacy and Dentistry of Alfenas). The school initially focused on pharmacy and dentistry education, laying the foundation for its future growth.

In 1969, significant changes occurred when the institution was federalized, becoming part of the Brazilian Federal University system. This transformation led to the expansion of academic programs and the introduction of various fields of study, broadening the university's scope beyond pharmacy and dentistry.

Throughout its history, UNIFAL has consistently emphasized academic involvement. The university has gained recognition for its contributions to science, culture, and society, and it continues to attract scholars and students from across Brazil and the world.
